## **IMPACT and Refuge Missionary Baptist Church Team Up To Provide Heating Assistance to Families in Need**

IMPACT Community Action (IMPACT) and Refuge Missionary Baptist Church are joining forces to host Super Saturday events to help Franklin County families in need stay warm this winter! IMPACT's event will be held on Saturday, January 12, 2013 at 700 Bryden Road in Columbus, Ohio 43215 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Refuge Missionary Baptist Church will host its event on Saturday, January 19, 2013 at 400 North 20<sup>th</sup> Street in Columbus, Ohio 43203 from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Up to 65 walk-in customers will be served at each event on a first-come, first-served basis. Customers are encouraged to arrive early at both events.

"More snow and freezing temperatures are on the way and many families need heating assistance. Our 'Super Saturdays' provide additional access to the Home Energy Assistance/Winter Crisis Program (HEAP/WCP) and the weekend hours and satellite locations help meet people at their points of need," said Regina Clemons, Director of Emergency Assistance at IMPACT. "We're excited to partner with the Reverend Kaiser W. Jones, Jr. and the congregation at Refuge Missionary Baptist Church to serve our community. Our common goal is to make a difference in the lives of families and to provide stability."

**Customers must bring the following information with them to the Super Saturday event:**

1. Valid, government-issued photo identification (i.e., a driver's license)
2. Social Security cards (or print out) for everyone in the household
3. Proof of income\* for the past 90 days for everyone in the household age 18 and older
4. Current gas and/or electric bills
5. A copy of the lease, if the service is currently disconnected

\*HEAP/WCP helps low-income families at or below 200% of the federal poverty guideline:

The HEAP/WCP runs from November 1, 2012 through March 31, 2013. The HEAP/WCP program provides a one-time payment up to \$175 for utility service and also assists with PIPP PLUS. The water assistance program provides a one-time payment up to \$250 for customers who have a documentable emergency. Appointments may be scheduled by calling 866.747.1038.
